SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

- Two scholarships will be awarded to outstanding young women from the Riverside area who have exhibited academic excellence and participated in community and extra-curricular activities. Our scholarship is NOT solely need-based, we look at all high school activities, grades, and accomplishments.
- The total amount of the scholarship is not to exceed \$4,000, and will be disbursed over a period of four years at a rate of \$1000 per academic year.
- The scholarship is renewed and disbursed at the beginning of each quarter/semester.
- The requirement for scholarship renewal are as follows:
 - You must attend college full time (as defined by your college or university)
 - You must provide a transcript and progress report every quarter/semester
 - You must maintain a "C" or better grade point average (2.0 at most schools)
 - You must meet all other guidelines which will be provided to scholarship recipients
- To assist with initiation fees, up to \$200 will be awarded in the event that you join a National Panhellenic Conference Sorority.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- You must be a female, graduating, high school senior from Riverside, Alvord, Jurupa or Moreno Valley School Districts or a private high school in the Riverside area.
- You must be planning to attend a four-year college or university where National Panhellenic Conference Sororities are represented (list available from your counselor).
- You must have an overall grade point average of 3.5 or greater for all high school coursework.

INSTRUCTIONS

To be complete, you application packet must include the following:

- The attached application with the signatures of yourself, your legal guardian and your counselor
- Two typed essays on the given topics
- Two letters of recommendation from people acquainted with your academic abilities and/or your extra-curricular or community activities
- A copy of your current, official, high school transcript including SAT scores
- Your name at the top of every piece of paper submitted
