

**RIVERSIDE ALUMNAE PANHELLENIC ASSOCIATION
SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES 2010**

Once the scholarship is awarded, the recipient must:

1. Maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 2.0. GPA computation includes all courses attempted and completed.
2. Complete at least 12 units per semester or quarter
3. Remain in a college or university where there are National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) sororities.
4. Send a transcript of grades for each semester or quarter to the Scholarship Disbursement Chairwoman.
5. Be aware that under no circumstances will the scholarship money be held for more than 12 months.
6. Be aware of the circumstances which would cause the scholarship to be forfeited (as described later in this document.)
7. Maintain an occasional amiable correspondence with the Scholarship Disbursement Chairwoman.

Scholarship Description

1. This scholarship shall be paid to a graduating high school girl from the Riverside area.
2. The total amount of this scholarship shall not exceed \$xxxx to be paid over a period of four years at the rate of \$xxxx each year (\$xxx per semester or \$xxxxx per quarter.)
3. If the recipient is initiated into a National Panhellenic Conference sorority, Riverside Alumnae Panhellenic Association shall pay an additional \$200 upon notification from the sorority.
4. Scholarship money shall be paid directly to the recipient **AFTER the Scholarship Disbursement Chairwoman has received the transcript showing completed courses and grades for the previous semester or quarter. If eligibility requirements as above are met, the check will be sent promptly.**

5. If the recipient's GPA falls below 2.0 for any one semester or quarter or if the recipient completes fewer than 12 units for any one semester or quarter, the scholarship money shall not be paid for that semester or quarter. This portion of the scholarship is thus forfeited, and the recipient's total scholarship is reduced by that amount. Regular payment of scholarship money will resume when the recipient has once again met the aforementioned criteria.

6. In the following cases, scholarship money can be held up to but not in excess of 12 months. The payment of scholarship money in these cases is suspended but not forfeited. That is, regular payments shall resume after the period of holding and continue until the total of \$xxxx is paid so long as there have been no forfeited semesters or quarters, the recipient attends a university or college where there are NPC sororities, maintains a minimum 2.0 GPA and completes at least 12 units per semester or quarter.
 - a. Illness
 - b. Insufficient funds
 - c. Other reasons that the Riverside Alumnae Panhellenic Association Board considers valid for holding the scholarship and which are considered individually and voted on by the Board Members

7. In the following cases the scholarship money shall be forfeited, thus reducing the total amount of the scholarship.
 - a. The recipient changes enrollment to a college or university that has no NPC sororities.
 - b. Other reasons that the Riverside Alumnae Panhellenic Association Board considers invalid for holding the scholarship and which are considered individually and voted on by the Board Members.
 - c. If the recipient fails to send a transcript to the Scholarship Disbursement Chairwoman once, the recipient will be reminded. If this happens a second time, the Board will review the scholarship, and cancellation will be considered.
